

There are communities in California, the sixth largest economy in the world, where underprivileged populations do not have access to clean water. **River Partners** makes a profound difference by restoring wildlife habitat which improves water quality and saves multi-million gallons of water annually for the benefit of people and the environment.

quality

We are sustaining the health of the Tuolumne and the Mokelumne Rivers, where San Francisco and East Bay residents get their water. For every 33 acres of habitat that River Partners has restored, we have retired enough surplus water to supply 400 Bay Area households annually.

fish



populations

To date, River Partner's projects have provided **over 650 TRILLION gallons of water annually** to our rivers which would have otherwise been removed for industrial and agricultural use. This was achieved at a cost of less than **\$0.02 per gallon**. Our habitat restoration has had a direct positive impact on salmon in the Sacramento and San Joaquin Rivers.

endangered



wildlife

We acquire land and plant native trees and shrubs to produce optimal outcomes for wildlife. River Partners has restored 11,000 acres of habitat along 13 western rivers, providing healthy nesting sites and migration corridors that endangered wildlife can depend on year-round.

California, the country's largest food producer, uses nearly 80 percent of its freshwater for agricultural purposes. Severe drought, like the one that struck in 2014, cost the state more than seventeen thousand jobs and over \$2.2 billion in economic losses.

Water: For every 1,000 acres of land we restore, we save enough water for 35,000 Californians per year



Habitat: \$100,000 in donations (matched x 10) = 100 acres of riverside land restored



Trees: \$10,000 in donations (matched x 10) = 220 trees planted per acre



Jobs: \$10,000 in donations (matched x 10) = 6 full time jobs for one year for underprivileged youth 18-24 years old

** We grow a self-sustaining, riverside forest in 3-5 years. An average project costs \$1 million-\$3 million.*
