Position Description:

The Strategic and Legal Advisor will lead strategy development and risk management, as well as all strategic legal and regulatory engagements for River Partners' body of land and water acquisition and restoration projects. This position works closely with the entire Leadership Team and reports directly to the President. Day to day activities include external and partnership related activities including participation in regional planning with local government partners, engagements with external counsel on private and public matters, and participation in various strategic NGO coalitions including developing and delivering strategic communications and presentations. In addition, this position partners with the Leadership Team to develop and support internal strategies to advance restoration and staff/partner mentorship activities to enhance skills and capacities in the restoration sector.

Supervisory Responsibilities: This position has supervisory responsibilities.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities of This Position Include:

Lead Legal and Regulatory Engagements - 50% (projects)

- Provide guidance and oversight to project managers regarding routine contracting and agreement development and execution.
- Lead and manage external legal engagements regarding contracting, real estate, water rights and dedications, public funds administration, local government participation, and other topics as requested.
- Cultivate strategic external project and agency partnerships to support project funding, permitting, and delivery.
- Communicate organizational and project-related legal and regulatory issues with River Partners' Board of Directors, staff and partners during regular meetings and planning sessions.

Assist in Partnership Development and Local Planning – 30% (program)

- Create written and verbal communication pieces in collaboration with the President, Senior Conservation Director, and Planning Director to support partnerships that deliver new project concepts and funding for River Partners' mission.
- Actively participate in strategic NGO and local government collaboratives that generate relevant plans and initiatives that may assist River Partners in its mission delivery. Such collaboratives may include working groups, joint ventures, and partnerships led by government agencies, NGOs, or River Partners
- Contribute to River Partners' blog, social media, and web presence with photos, written content, and links.

Support Strategy Development and Risk Management – 10% (admin)

• Work closely with the President, CFO, and Senior Directors to track and evaluate organizational risks and performance against strategic plan, assist in the development and revision of strategic and operational plans, and present risks and strategies to the Board of Directors as requested.



- Work closely with Directors of Science, Planning, Acquisitions, Operations, Grants and Contracts to track and understand dynamic risks and opportunities for River Partners' projects (both underway and in development) and develop strategies to mitigate risks and realize strategic opportunities to expand restoration project delivery.
- Cultivate strategic external legal and governmental partnerships to support projects and policy improvements.
- Track and communicate relevant policy developments with River Partners' staff and leadership during regular meetings and training.

Assist in Staff Mentorship and Training – 10%

- Assist the President and Leadership Team in tracking performance and developing/deploying Board-derived Strategic Plans and staff-derived Operations Plans for River Partners' work, especially regarding public funds administration, land and water conservation dedications, and risk management policies and practices.
- Occasionally mentor staff and provide internal workshops to enhance project management performance and reduce organizational risks.
- Participate in the recruitment and training of new staff.

Other

• Performs other assignments from time to time as requested by the President to achieve department and company business goals.

Essential Knowledge Skills and Abilities:

- Ability, vision, and energy to lead River Partners' work.
- Interest, enthusiasm, and ability to manage productive partnerships that support legal, regulatory, funding, and operational capacity growth for river restoration.
- A self-starter who can work individually or on a team and succeed with limited direction, under changing conditions.
- Ability to navigate differences of opinion with poise and focus.
- Unsurpassed written communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to work well under pressure, multitask, and prioritize workload.
