#### **Position Description**

The Seasonal Seed Cleaning Technician works with Heritage Growers (a venture of River Partners) to process raw field material brought in by our Wildland Collections team and produce cleaned seed that will be used to amplify plants on Heritage Growers' farm. The Seed Cleaning Technician will be responsible for operating a multitude of equipment including, but not limited to, a small seed cleaning mill, an array of power tools and hand cleaning screens. This position will be located at Heritage Growers' seed cleaning facility located at 7681 Sycamore Slough Rd. in Colusa CA. There may be times when the technician also assists the farm team when work is slow in the warehouse which includes, but is not limited to, monitoring crops for ripeness, checking fields for weeds, implementing weed control measures including hoeing, tracking harvested crops, imputing data and testing harvested seeds for moisture. This position will also require some computer work, which will include working with Microsoft Word, Excel and other data collection databases. The position requires some prior knowledge of plant physiology, but most important is a willingness to learn and an ability to pay attention to details.

#### **Essential Functions and Responsibilities**

- Breakdown field material and produce cleaned seed
- Operate seed cleaning machinery to achieve goals
- Track data (weights, cleaning logs, location)
- Manage collected field material
- Assist with collecting samples of cleaned seed
- Assistance with data collection of the production farm
- Ability to work independently under the guidance of the Heritage Growers management team
- Detailed record keeping
- Clear communication across many teams and stakeholders
- Other assignments as requested to achieve seed cleaning goals

#### Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities

- Passionate about learning
- Proficiency in identifying seeds
- Exceptional time-management and organizational skills
- Able to quickly adapt and problem solve
- Demonstrate cooperative behavior with colleagues, supervisors, and managers at all times
- Has a good understanding of appropriate work attire
- Strong working knowledge of common computer applications including excel
- Track record of delivering high-quality results under tight deadlines
- Ability to be on your feet all day
- Ability to routinely lift 25-50 lb. bags of seed
- Able to work in warm weather conditions
- Prioritizes safety around equipment
- A valid driver's license with a clean DMV record
- Interest in native seed and the development of best methods to process native seed using a variety of methods and equipment

- Prior experience with seed mills preferred but not required
- Some familiarity with native plants or willingness to learn
- Experience with power tools/air compressors
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
