The Plant Materials Sales Administrator works with Heritage Growers' (a venture of River Partners) General Manager and Operations Manager to facilitate the sales of source identified native seeds, plants, and straw to support habitat restoration. This work includes the development of native seed and nursery plant bids and designs, assisting with plant and seed inventory management, advising customers and project partners on effective native seed and plant designs (with training provided) as well as providing general administrative support to Heritage Growers' management team in the operation of this dynamic and expanding business. Flexibility, creativity, and problem-solving skills are required to support the sales and general administration of the Heritage Growers business. The position requires a basic understanding of



habitat restoration, native seed, native plants, and native plant communities. Other work associated with this position includes, but is not limited to, assisting with data management, preparing supporting documents for sales, preparing annual reports, developing detailed budgets, assisting with grants management, and other administrative functions necessary to support the sales of native plant materials and assistance with Heritage Growers operations. Opportunities to occasional assist with wildland seed collections and related field activities are possible for the right candidate.
